Dear Parents

We have been lucky enough to access funding from Greggs Bakery Foundation in order to set up a Breakfast Club in school from September. The aim is to provide a simple nutritious breakfast in order to set pupils up for the school day. We still have a high percentage of pupils who attend school after eating no or an inappropriate breakfast.

We have initially secured funding for two years. Breakfast will be free to pupils who claim free school meals and there is a small charge for items above the standard breakfast on offer. Pupils who do not have free school meals will also be able to purchase breakfast according to the price list which will be published before the end of term.

We will initially start with space for 30 pupils. By October half term we will have a clearer idea of potential numbers and will adjust the capacity accordingly.

The facility will be open in the school hall on 8th September. Pupils can arrive to the club at 8.15am and will go into classes for the start of the school day. Funding has also been accessed to provide activities for the pupils during this period. The facility will be staffed by Jacqui Wallace and Lyndsey Wilson.

This will be a non-profit making organisation. If found to be financially sustainable, any excess funding will be used to reduce the cost of breakfasts on offer, purchase more equipment or raise staff numbers.
